


As the virus rages, gig companies throughout the world continue to exploit workers and refuse to abide by labor laws.

Multinational platforms must adhere to universal labor rights:

1) Recognize delivery workers and drivers as salaried workers (not partners, not users, not collaborators, not independent contractors, not self-employed).

2) Justice for colleagues who died due to road accidents or COVID-19 infections.

3) End to arbitrary blocks and suspensions for the alleged violation of terms and conditions. Reinstatement and compensation for those laid off.

4) Collective bargaining agreements, negotiated with representative organizations of workers.
